DRESS CODE

MASK REQUIREMENT (REGARDLESS OF COVID-19 VACCINE STATUS)

Staff and volunteers are required to wear a mask covering both the nose and mouth at all times.

Volunteers not wearing the correct attire will not be able to participate.

Please leave personal belongings at home (purses, backpacks, etc.) We do not have secure storage.

YOUTH AND CHAPERONE POLICY

(1 adult may chaperone up to 5 minors (under 18 years of age))

If this ratio is not maintained your group will be asked to leave and reschedule.

Chaperones **MUST** be actively supervising and volunteering alongside the minor(s) throughout the entire volunteer experience. Chaperones cannot be seated.

Minors are not to be left unattended at any time.

PARKING
